

## Callaway Golf's ERC II Driver #1 On PGA European Tour

The ERC II Driver conforms to the Rules of Golf everywhere in the world except for the United States, Canada and Mexico. In those countries, which follow the Rules of Golf as interpreted by the USGA, the ERC II Driver has been ruled non-conforming because it exceeds the USGA regulations for ``spring- like effect.'' In those countries, Callaway Golf recommends that the ERC II Driver be used only for rounds of recreational golf.
